Contest Overview

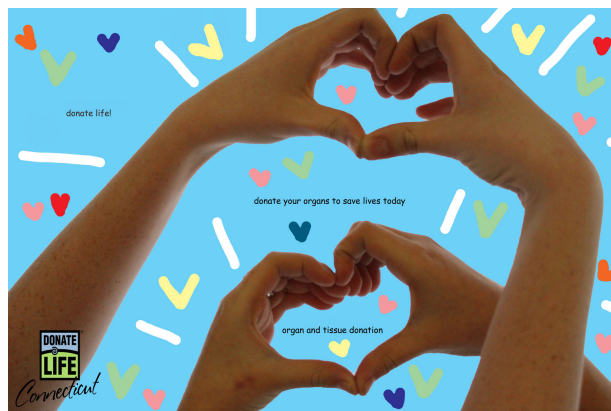
